Dr. Ron Do is a post-doctoral research fellow at the Center for Human Genetics Research at Massachusetts General Hospital, Broad Institute and Harvard Medical School. He has investigated the effects of genetic variants on lipids and coronary disease using a variety of approaches including fine-mapping, gene-environment interaction and meta-analysis methods in gene association studies. Currently, Dr. Do is studying the role of low-frequency and very rare mutations in case-

control samples for early-onset myocardial infarction using exome sequencing technology. He is also currently integrating genetic findings from genome-wide association studies for lipid traits with findings for coronary disease.
